Introduction



Historical Center of Santiago

It is the sector with the greatest concentration of the city's heritage, the Plaza de Armas and its surroundings hide in each of its corners, the Chile's history. Ancient buildings such as the Municipality of Santiago, the Cathedral of Santiago, the National Historical Museum, the Courts of Justice, among others, are part of the historical circuit as a whole classic Paseo Ahumada.

Sky Costanera

Opened in 2015, Sky Costanera promises an experience in 360 ° of the city, 300 meters high, on floors 61 and 62 of the tower, the viewpoint is consecrated as one of the required destinations; do not only tourists, but also lovers of the capital of Santiago and its incredible view from the top. Access is allowed for all ages, in addition to a reduced fee for students of \$ 4,000 CLP.

Traditional neighborhoods

From cultural labyrinths, outdoor art, bohemian streets famous for its nocturnal display and corners where everything can be found, typical gastronomy, authentic articles, antiques and showcases avant-garde, all this and much more make up the traditional neighborhoods of Santiago: Barrio Lastarria and Bellas Artes, Barrio Italia and Barrio Bellavista.

Metropolitan Park of Santiago

It is the largest urban park in the city with an area of 712 hectares, divided into hills San Cristóbal, Blanco, Chascarillas, Pyramid and the Santiago Forest. Composed of large green areas, picnic areas, viewpoints, swimming pools, National Zoo and the emblematic Virgin of the Immaculate Conception from above.

Park Network Association Cordillera

In it, your visitors have the possibility to visit more than 110 Km of trails of the network, which is made up of five parks Cordilleran natural resources administered directly by the Association: Puente Ñilhue Park (Lo Barnechea), San Carlos de Apoquindo Park (Las Condes), Aguas de Ramón Park (limit communes La Reina and Las Condes), Parque Cantalao (Peñalolén) and Quebrada de Macul Park.
